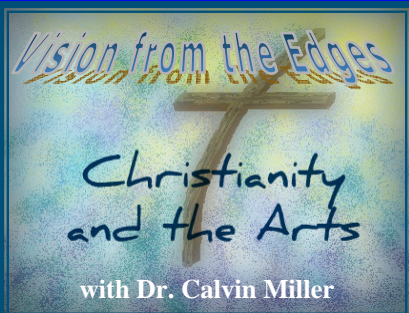

DR. DENNIS WILES WILL BE FEATURED SPEAKER AT BHCTI CONVOCAATION

B. H. Carroll Theological Institute will hold its fifth convocation on Tuesday, June 1, at Agape Baptist Church in Fort Worth, Texas. **Dr. Dennis Wiles**, senior pastor of First Baptist Church of Arlington, will be the keynote speaker for the event. Dr. Wiles is a friend and supporter of Carroll Institute and shares its vision and mission to prepare men and women for global ministry. Dr. Wiles addressed students, faculty, and guests four years ago at Carroll Institute's Summer Colloquy, challenging them to be passionate in their calling. "Over the years, what I have noticed — not just in my own ministry, but what I've noticed historically — is that passionate people change the world," Wiles said. "It's people who truly believe in a cause, who truly believe they have something worth fighting for — that's the kind of people who inspire movements." This kind of passion rings true with Carroll Institute's core values of being responsive and relevant to a changing world as it trains leaders and encourages churches to have a global impact.



A native of Birmingham, Alabama, Dr. Wiles accepted the call as Pastor of First Baptist Church, Arlington in July of 2001. Prior to coming to Arlington, he served as pastor for six years at First Baptist Church, Huntsville, Alabama. Dr. Wiles received a Ph.D. in Church History from Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary and served as a Teaching Fellow specializing in Baptist History in the Department of Church History from 1986-1987. He currently serves as an Adjunct Professor in Preaching at Truett Seminary, Baylor University.

Dr. Wiles and his wife, Cindy, have partnered together in ministry and missions around the world. Their mission trips have taken them to Belize, Mexico, Bangladesh, Morocco, Senegal, Ghana, The Gambia and Spain. Cindy is executive director of Global Connection Partnership Network where Dennis also serves on the Board of Directors.

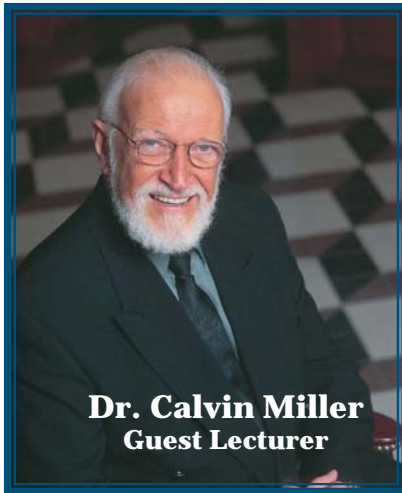

Dr. Calvin Miller is a widely-popular author, artist, and preacher. Since 1999 he has served on the faculty of Samford University's Beeson Divinity School in Birmingham, Alabama, where he is currently Professor of Preaching and Pastoral Ministry.

Dr. Miller is considered a contemporary apologist, helping the church provide answers for a secular culture, as well as being an equipper of the contemporary church for the task of missions and evangelism.

He is author of more than forty books of popular theology and inspiration. His poems and free-lance articles have appeared in various journals and magazines. Some of his most well-known books include:
